## Civil Protection Test Alarm

all over Austria

on **Saturday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2010, between 12:00 a.m. and 01:00 p.m.**

Austria has a nationwide warning and alerting system. It is possible to warn or alert the population in case of emergency with more than 8.120 sirens.

To familiarize you with the civil protection signals and at the same time to test the operability of the warning and alert system once a year

**a Civil Protection Test Alarm is carried out all over Austria,**

operated jointly by the Federal Alarm Centre at the Federal Ministry of the Interior and the offices of the governments of the Federal Provinces.

### Meaning of the signals

#### Testing of operability of sirens



15 seconds

#### Warning

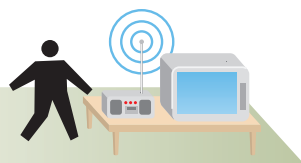


**3 minutes** steady continuous tone

#### Approaching danger!

Turn on radio or television (ORF) respectively internet ([www.orf.at](http://www.orf.at)), follow the rules of conduct.

#### Alarm

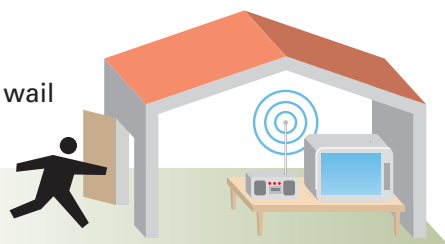


**1 minute** ascending and descending wail

#### Danger!

Look for protective areas or rooms, follow the rules of conduct announced over radio or television (ORF) respectively internet ([www.orf.at](http://www.orf.at)).

#### All-clear



**1 minute** steady continuous tone

#### End of danger!
